Goals

Division C team goals were to aim for four distinguished clubs, to promote DCP to our clubs and to support clubs in growing membership numbers. In setting these goals we are hoping to empower members to be better speakers and better leaders. As of the 28th of June, we have achieved 2 Distinguished Clubs (Lunchspeak (C4), and Greymouth (C6)). Congratulations to Dunedin Toastmasters(C4) who have achieved Presidents Distinguished. This leaves us one club short of our goal of 4 distinguished clubs. Looking back to our other goals of promoting the DCP and supporting clubs with growing membership, my feeling is that we have had mixed results. We have sadly bid farewell to Scarifies Speechcraft Club. We also have more clubs with 12 members or less than we did at the start of the term. We have seen many new members join, but working on retaining these members and growing membership remains an important goal for Division C.
